

The activity fields of Kogayon Association are: heritage conservation (biodiversity, geodiversity and cultural heritage), establishment and management of protected natural areas and geoparks, natural resources management, environmental education, ecotourism, research, sustainable development.

The Kogayon Association is active mainly in Oltenia de sub Munte and Buila-Vânturariţa National Park, to whose creation made a decisive contribution, as well as at national level.

The Kogayon Association was involved in the establishment of the Văcărești Natural Park and other environmental projects at national level (Green Belt of Bucharest, Law of Remarkable Trees); in addition, it is a member of the Urban Nature Network.

The main achievements of the Kogayon Association, so far:

- Establishment of the Buila-Vânturarița National Park (2004).
- Co-administration of Buila-Vânturarița National Park (2006-2016), by implementing more than 20 projects, worth more than 300.000 euros, aiming at: development of the park's tourist infrastructure, environmental education programs (Junior Ranger), monitoring, studies and research, promotion, information and raising awareness.
- Administration of the Natural Reserve Costești Trovantilor Museum (2006-2016).
- Hunting stop in national parks (2007) and other nature conservation campaigns (Green Belt of Bucharest, The Law of Remarkable Trees).
- Involvement in the establishment and management of the Văcărești Natural Park (2012-2023) and in the Network for Urban Natural Areas.
