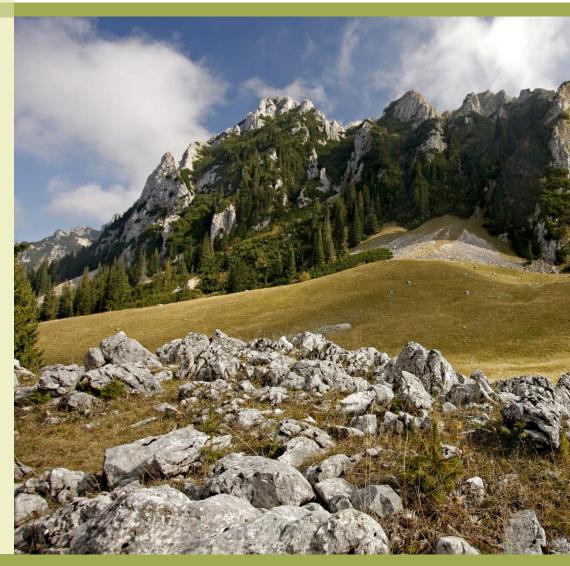


# **Activity Report for 2024**







Kogayon Association is an environmental NGO founded in 2004, based in Costești-Vâlcea.

The activity areas of the Kogayon Association include the conservation of heritage (biodiversity, geodiversity, and cultural heritage), the establishment and management of protected natural areas and geoparks, natural resource management, environmental education, ecotourism, research, and sustainable development.

Kogayon Association primarily operates in Oltenia de sub Munte and Buila-Vânturarița National Park. The Association has been involved in the establishment of Văcărești Natural Park and is now working on the development of the Urban Natural Areas Network, as well as other environmental projects at the national level, such as the Green Belt of Bucharest, the Remarkable Trees Law, the Forestry Code, and more.

#### Goal:

To turn Oltenia de sub Munte into a model for sustainable development based on local natural and cultural heritage and community involvement



#### Vision:

By 2030, Oltenia de sub Munte becomes a model for regional development, based on the promotion and valorization of the local natural and cultural heritage, with the involvement of local communities and visitors to the area.

#### **Objectives:**

**1. To triple the number of visitors** and increase the average number of days they spend in the territory

**2. To double the value of public and private investment** for the benefit of local communities and visitors

**3. To maintain the favorable conservation status of biodiversity** and geodiversity and the social, economic and ecological regeneration of the territory through research, monitoring and regeneration programs

There are other two milestone objectives, linked to the UNESCO International Geopark status as a development tool:

4. To obtain the status of UNESCO International Geopark

5. To administrate the UNESCO International Geopark Oltenia de sub Munte

2024 was a year of mission validation of the Kogayon team and the development accelerated through partnerships, events and promotion.

**Challenges:** withdrawal of the UNESCO Application because of the opposition of Horezu Local Council

#### Goal:

To support and develop local entrepreneurial and social ideas and projects.

We initiated **the local grant program**, supported by BRD and Commonland (Bioregional Weaving Labs) where we selected the entrepreneurial ideas in the community with the highest potential. We provided funding to the first 4 projects, worth over 35.000 euro:

- The local gastronomic point *Bucătăria Elenei* (Elena's Kitchen) in Vaideeni - modern equipment, promotion and development
- The itinerant photo exhibition Vâlcea Naturală launched at the Fireflies Festival and presented in several cities (Sibiu, Cluj, Călimănești); this year, the exibit will reach other cities as well
- **Buila Trail Race Marathon** 3rd edition, with over 600 participants; we were a main sponsor
- Launching of the book *Cartea Depresiilor* (*The Depressions Book*), coordinated by the writer Marius Chivu

## **The Fireflies Festival**

After the success of the first edition in 2023, we organized two editions in 2024. The event is an example for local development - all the products and related services (accommodation, meals, craft workshops, products) are local, and this generates a market and exposure for it.



The festival is already a sustainable event, which brings us profit to support the geopark.



# The territory development Infrastructure and products



# **Local Products:**

- The launch of the wines *Negru de Drăgășani* and *Crâmpoșie* under the Oltenia de sub Munte brand. These types of grapes originate from the Oltenia wine-growing region
- The launch of local promotional products: honey, plum brandy

# Tourism Infrastructure:

- Refurbishment of the thematic trails *Forest Tales* and *A walk through Oltenia*
- Development of the geopark headquarters and dozens of information points, renewal of their signs
- 3D scanning for two historical monuments and preparation for 20 others
- Preparing the inauguration of The Road of the Outlaws, equestrian and cycle tourism trail
- Preparation of thematic trails with local partners following the model Costești village hearth
- Creation of a painted map
- Extending the discover-oltenia.ro platform with an app
- Starting the initiation school for local guides

#### **Documentary films:**

- Discover Oltenia, directed by Charlie Ottley has become the region's best promotional product. It exceeded 1,000,000 views online and had two launches: a community preview and a Bucharest premiere. It was presented at various national and international festivals and events
- Oltenia de sub Munte will have a dedicated episode in Flavours of Romania, season 3, coming on Netflix in 2025
- Oamenii Olteniei de sub Munte (The People of Oltenia de sub Munte) was launched internationally online in January 2025; we are also preparing the offline launch amidst the community
- Romania's Geoparks due to be launched in 2025
- The media exposure has been significant and is growing, with over 85 written, audio and video pieces appearing in leading national publications



# The territory development Local strategy

### Strategy for local development Oltenia de sub Munte



- We have continued the program of social, economic and environmental regeneration of the territory of Oltenia de sub Munte, together with partners from 10 European countries, associated with BWL (Bioregional Weaving Labs).
- Together with Urbasofia, we have finalized the territorial assessment phase and will continue with the involvement of the stakeholders
- The information will be used to produce guides for those who want to relocate here from the city
- We have reached the 4th online survey addressed to the inhabitants and visitors of Oltenia de sub Munte
- We continued the series of thematic meetings and debates in the local community
- We organized in Vaideeni a meeting dedicated to entrepreneurs from Oltenia de sub Munte, with the participation of guests from relevant organizations in the field of tourism
- We prepared the Oltenia Travel Forum the event will bring together tourism experts and professionals
- We are working with tourism entrepreneurs to develop and implement a local standard for tourism services
- We organized a debate on ecotourism, moderated by Charlie Ottley
- We worked on a program to monitor and research the biodiversity of the territory using modern methods and technologies, in partnership with the Buila-Vânturarița National Park Administration



#### **Education**

#### Goal:

- Outdoor educational activities; classes, hikes, camps, excursions
- Setting up a natural science laboratory



- We resumed the Junior Ranger program, which will be implemented during 2024 and 2025, in collaboration with two high schools, one special school and two secondary schools in Oltenia de sub Munte
- We have begun setting up a laboratory for natural sciences in Horezu High School and have organized lessons and hikes with students
- The team dedicated to this project is working on transforming the educational program into a self-sustainable activity by introducing a commercial component to generate profit for the continuation of *pro bono* activities
- We have strengthened the *Geoclubs in Schools* program with plans to expand it to every school in the geopark
- For the Horezu Geoclub, we rented and set up a meeting space for members, students and teachers
- We carried out educational activities in the framework of the *Green School* program and the *Different Week* (Săptămâna Altfel), and we are working on strengthening a permanent educational offer for these initiatives

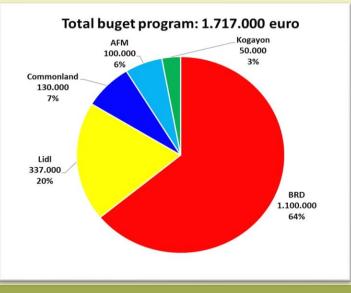

#### Financial and human resources

- The year 2024 marked a pivotal moment for our organization: we made the transition from a volunteer-based model to a professionalized one
- · Before 2023 we had one employee, a Project Coordinator
- The Activities and projects were supported for 20 years exclusively on a voluntary basis
- In 2004 the team grew to 13 employees: program manager, tourism expert, 2 financial managers, communication specialist, education and research manager, local communities manager, 2 education, research and tourism specialists. In addition, we financially support 5 employees from RNU organizations, one employee in Carpaterra Geopark and one Research Hub coordinator.

#### Goal:

To develop the Urban Nature Network through partnerships, studies, research, advocacy and community engagement



## Vision:

By 2030, we want at least one urban natural area established in every county in Romania.

Based on the experience of the Văcărești N.P. Association, in January 2024 the **Urban Nature Network (RNU)** was established, consisting of 15 organizations from 10 large cities, which aim to protect 23 urban natural areas.

A total of 8 grants, worth  $\in$  86,000, have been allocated for the development of the network's projects:

- Design and installation of thematic trails in Arad, Bistriţa, Iaşi and Satu Mare
- Advocacy
- Discussions continue with the Environment Ministry and Parliament on the regulation of urban natural areas
- Amendments were proposed to two draft HGs for the Green Week and Junior Ranger programs
- In Cluj, the Metropolitan Green Ring project was initiated

#### - Events, education

- 42 events in the 10 cities with over 600 participants
- 4th edition of the Environmental School for Journalists in Costești -Nov 24
- Forest Day: images from geoparks and urban natural areas displayed on monitors in Bucharest



# 3. The development of the Romanian Geoparks Network

Running period: 2023-2030 Beneficiars: local communities in geopark territories and visitors Funders: BRD Groupe Société Générale Budget: 88.000 euros

### Goal:

Developing the Romanian Geoparks Network through partnerships, joint projects, studies, research, advocacy and community involvement





**The Network Structure -** includes 2 UNESCO geoparks (Țara Hațegului and Ținutul Buzăului), one aspiring geopark (Oltenia de sub Munte), one geopark that is about to submit its application (Carpaterra) and 2 other projects in development (Dobrogea Chimerică and Gutâi).

### **Financial Support**

We offer funding for human resources in Carpaterra Geopark to prepare the UNESCO 2025 application

**Organizational activities:** We organized the Romanian Geoparks Forum and 3 network meetings.

### **Educational Projects:**

- Expansion of the Young Geopark Ambassadors program and the establishment of the Geopark Youth Forum

- Researchers' Night Project - online and offline educational activities in 4 territories

#### **Events and Programs**:

- We supported events such as the *Oak Day* and the *Researchers' Night in Geoparks* 

- We are producing a film and photo album dedicated to the 4 geoparks

## Plans for 2025:

Finalizing the network strategy, organizing joint events and developing the infrastructure for visitors.
